



# Autumn Walk

## Cowl

**Yarn:** 1 skein (≈ 420 m/459 yds) of Scheepjes Invicta Colour (fingering weight), color 963

**Hook:** 3.5 mm

**Measurements:** approx 75 x 24 cm / 29.5 x 9.5”

*The size can be customized – see below. Please note that the neck opening will be narrower if you make the scarf wider*

**Gauge:** 20 dc and 10 rows = 10 x 10 cm / 4 x 4”

## Abbreviations (US terms)

st	stitch
sl st	slip stitch
ch	chain
ch sp	chain space
sc	single crochet
hdc	half double crochet
dc	double crochet
W	[1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc] in the same st
* - *	repeat
FO	fasten off

## Notes

- The cowl is made of a rectangle, which is folded and sewn or crocheted together. Then you make the edging
- The first dc on a row is replaced by ch 3
- Even rows = wrong side, odd rows = right side

Ch 63 *loosely*

(If you want to customize the width, the number of chains should be a multiple of 3 + ch 3)

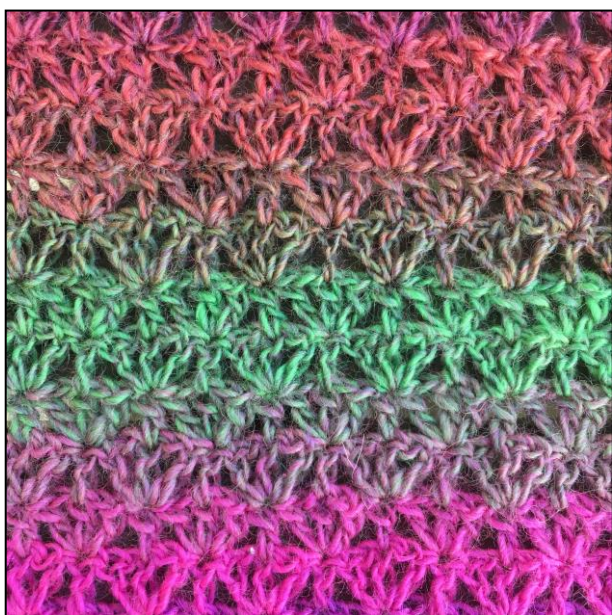
**Row 1:** Start in the 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, 1 dc in each ch, turn (61 dc)

**Row 2:** ch 5 (=1 dc+ch 2), skip 2 st, 1 dc, \*ch 2, skip 2 st, 1 dc\* across, turn (21 dc, 20 ch sp)

**Row 3:** ch 3 (=1 dc), \*skip ch sp, 1 W in the next dc, skip ch sp, 1 dc in the next dc\* across, turn (11 dc, 10 W)

**Row 4:** ch 5 (1 dc+ch 2), 1 dc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> dc in W, \*1 W in the single dc, 1 dc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> dc in next W\*, ch 2, 1 dc in the last st, turn (12 dc, 9 W)

**Row 5:** ch 3 (=1 dc), skip ch sp, 1 W in the single dc, \*1 dc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> dc in W, 1 dc in next single dc\*, skip ch sp, 1 dc in the last st, turn (11 dc, 10 W)



Repeat rows 4 and 5 until your work measures approx 75 cm / 29.5", or to desired length

**Row 6:** ch 1 (=1 sc), 1 sc in each dc and each ch-1 sp across

FO. Block your work

## *Assembly*

Place the rectangle wrong side up and fold as shown in picture.

Join with sl st or sew together across the dashed line. Make sure that the seam is on the wrong side

## *Edging*

Start with a standing sc at the tip

**Round 1:** \*1 sc, ch 3, skip 2 st\*, up until the seam where you joined the ends. 1 sc in the sc-row, ch 3, \*1 sc in the next row, ch 4, skip the next row\* around, sl st in the first sc

**Round 2:** sl st to the middle of the first ch sp, ch 1, 1 sc in ch sp, ch 4, \*1 sc in the next ch sp, ch 4\* around, sl st in the first sc

**Round 3:** sl st into ch sp, [ch 2 (=1 hdc), 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, 1 hdc] in the same ch sp, \*[1 hdc, 1 dc, ch 1, 1 dc, 1 hdc] in the next ch sp\* around, sl st in the first st

Cut yarn

Work one round of sc around the neck opening. Work 3 sc in each ch sp/dc

FO. Block the edging
