Yarn: Scheepjes Catona (fingering weight) in 4 colors

Col A: approx. 12.5 m/14 yd, Col B: approx. 25 m/27 yd, Col C: approx. 12.5 m/14 yd, Col D: approx. 12.5 m/14 yd

Hook: 3.0 mm

Size: approx. 15 x 15 cm/6 x 6 IN

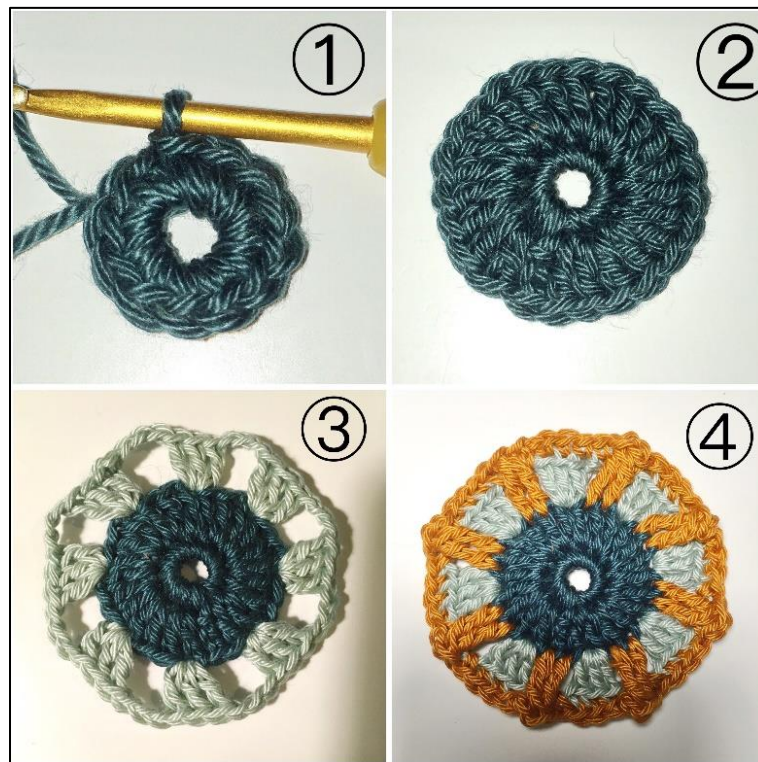

fpdc3tog	front post double crochet 3 together
tr	triple crochet
tr2tog	triple crochet 2 together
ptr	front post triple crochet
ptr3tog	front post triple crochet 3 together
BL	back loop

Notes

- Skill level: intermediate
- You can use any yarn, but please note that this will affect the size of your square
- The first st on each round is worked as a standing st, or is replaced by:
hdc – ch 2, dc – ch 3, tr – ch 4
- Close each round with an invisible join, or a sl st to the first st
- Stitch count in (-) at the end of each round
- Color code (A-D) at the beginning of each round
- Not all skipped stitches are mentioned in the pattern. If a stitch isn't mentioned, it should be skipped



Round 1 (A): ch 5, sl st in the first ch to form a ring (or make a magic ring), ch 1 (*do not count as a st*), 12 sc in the ring (12 sc). *Do not cut yarn.*

Round 2: 2 dc in each st around (24 dc)

Round 3 (B): Start in any st, *3 dc in the same st, ch 3, skip 2 st*

(24 dc, 8 ch-3 sp)

Round 4 (C): Start in any ch sp, *1 sc in ch sp, ch 1, tr2tog over the 2 skipped sts of rnd 2 (*work in front of ch sp of previous rnd*), ch 1, 1 sc in the same ch sp as last made sc, 3 sc in *BL** (8 tr2tog, 16 ch-1 sp, 40 sc)



Round 5 (B): Start in any ch-1 sp before tr2tog, *1 sc in ch-1 sp, 1 fpdc around tr2tog, 1 sc in the next ch-1 sp, ch 3, fpdc3tog over the 3 dc of rnd 3, ch 3* (8 fpdc, 8 fpdc3tog, 16 ch-3 sp, 16 sc)

Round 6 (D): Start in any ch-3 sp before fpdc3tog, *5 dc in ch sp, 1 fpdc around fpdc3tog, 5 dc in the next ch sp, skip sc, 1 fpdc around fpdc, skip sc* (80 dc, 16 fpdc)

Round 7 (B): Start in the 3rd dc of any group of 5, *[2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the same st (=corner), {ch 2, skip 2 st, 1 fphdc around fpdc, ch 2, skip 2 st, 1 sc in the next st} X 3,

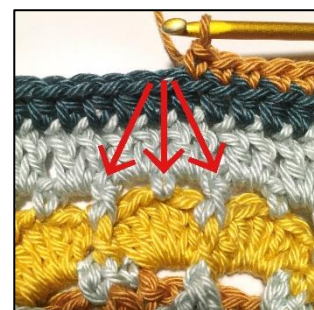
ch 2, skip 2 st, 1 fphdc around fpssc, ch 2, skip 2 st* (16 dc, 16 fphdc, 12 sc, 36 ch-2 sp). *Do not cut yarn.*

Round 8: *2 dc, [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in corner ch sp, 2 dc, 2 tr in ch sp, 2 dc in each of the next 6 ch sp, 2 tr in the next ch sp* (4 ch-2 sp, 16 tr, 80 dc)



Round 9 (A): Start in any corner ch sp, *[1 dc, ch 2, 1 dc] in corner ch sp, 24 hdc* (8 dc, 4 ch-2 sp, 96 hdc)

Round 10 (C): Start in any corner ch sp, *[1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc] in corner ch sp, skip 1 st, 12 sc in *BL*, fptr3tog with the 1st leg around the 2nd fphdc after corner of rnd 7, the 2nd leg around the next sc of rnd 7, and the 3rd leg around the next fphdc of rnd 7, skip 1 st, 12 sc in *BL** (4 fptr3tog, 4 ch-2 sp, 104 sc)



Round 11 (A): Start in any corner ch sp, *[1 sc, ch 2, 1 sc] in corner ch sp, 13 sc in *BL*, 1 fphdc around fp_{tr}3tog, 13 sc in *BL** (4 fphdc, 4 ch-2 sp, 112 sc)

Round 12 (D): Work one round of surface crochet between rnds 2 and 3, and one round between rnds 8 and 9 (work in the holes at the base of the stitches of the upper round). Do not work the stitches too tight. *Work behind the fp_{tr}3tog as follows: remove loop from hook, insert the hook behind the fp_{tr}3tog from left to right, pick up the loop and continue across.*



Fasten off. Weave in the ends. Block your finished square.
