



Daffodil

Tea light holder

Supplies

- LED battery tea light (do not use open flame!), approx 4 cm/1.5 IN in diameter
- Yarn: Scheepjes Catona, or similar, approx 25 m/27 yd
- Hook 3.0 mm
- Stitch marker (or a small piece of yarn)
- Darning needle for weaving in ends
- Scissors

Abbreviations (US terms)

st	stitch/-es
MR	magic ring
sl st	slip stitch
ch	chain
sc	single crochet
fp _{sc}	front post single crochet
tr	treble crochet
tr4tog	treble crochet 4 together
BL	back loop
FL	front loop
_	repeat around

Rounds 1 – 10 are worked in continuous rounds. Use a stitch marker to keep track of where the rounds start.

Round 1: 6 sc in MR (6 sc)

Round 2: 2 sc in each st (12 sc)

Round 3: *1 sc, 2 sc in the next st* (18 sc)

Round 4: *2 sc, 2 sc in the next st* (24 sc)

Round 5: *3 sc, 2 sc in the next st* (30 sc)

Round 6: *in BL*, 1 sc in each st (30 sc)

Rounds 7-9: 1 sc (in both loops) in each st (30 sc)

Round 10: *in BL*, 1 sl st in each st (30 sl st)

Fasten off.



Round 11: *The round is worked in FL of round 6. Make sure that the opening of the light holder is facing you.*

*Attach yarn with a sl st in any st, *ch 4, tr4tog over the next 4 st, ch 3, 1 fpst around tr4tog, ch 4, sl st in the next st* (= 6 petals). The last sl st of the round is worked in the same st as the initial sl st.*

Fasten off. Weave in all ends. Block your work if needed.
