Doily

Yarn: Falkgarn Emma 8/4 (fingering weight), approx 136 m/149 yd. Color 724, light purple

Hook: 2.5 mm

Size: approx 34 cm/13 IN in diameter after blocking

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Abbreviations (US terms)

st stitch/-es

sl st slip stitch

ch chain

ch-sp chain space

sc single crochet

dc double crochet

dc2tog double crochet 2 together

picot ch 3, sl st in the first ch

- repeat around

{ - } repeat the indicated number of times

[-] work in the same st


Notes

- Dc at the beginning of a round is replaced by ch 3
- Ch 1 before sc at the beginning of a round doesn't count as a st
- Close each round with a sl st to the first st
- Stitch count in () at the end of each round
- Not all skipped stitches are mentioned in the pattern. If a stitch isn't mentioned, it should be skipped
- Your work may appear slightly bowl shaped after some rounds, but will be flat after blocking

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Round 1: ch 5, sl st in the first ch to form a ring, 16 dc in the ring (16 dc)

Round 2: 2 dc in each st around (32 dc)

Round 3: ch 1, *1 sc, ch 3, skip 1 st* (16 sc, 16 ch-3 sp)

Round 4: sl st into ch-sp, ch 1, 1 sc in ch-sp, ch 5, *1 sc in the next ch-sp, ch 5* (16 sc, 16 ch-5 sp)

Round 5: sl st to the middle of ch-sp, ch 1, [1 sc, ch 5, 1 sc] in ch-sp, ch 3, *[1 sc, ch 5, 1 sc] in the next ch-sp, ch 3* (32 sc, 16 ch-5 sp, 16 ch-3 sp)

Round 6: sl st to the middle of ch-sp, ch 1, 1 sc in ch-5 sp, ch 6, *1 sc in the next ch-5 sp, ch 6* (16 sc, 16 ch-6 sp)

Round 7: sl st into ch-sp, *5 dc in ch-sp, dc2tog with the first leg in the same ch-sp as last made dc and the 2^{nd} leg in next ch-sp (= 1 leg on each side of sc)* (80 dc, 16 dc2tog)

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Round 8: *5 dc, 2 dc in the next st* (112 dc)

Round 9: *3 dc, 2 dc in the next st, 3 dc, ch 3, skip 1 st* (112 dc, 14 ch-3 sp)

Round 10: sl st to the 3rd dc of 8, *4 dc, ch 5, skip 2 dc, 1 sc in ch-sp, ch 5, skip


2 dc* (56 dc, 14 sc, 28 ch-5 sp)

Round 11: *4 dc, 3 dc in ch-sp, ch 1, 3 dc in the next ch-sp* (140 dc, 14 ch-1 sp)

Round 12: *7 dc, 1 dc in ch-sp, 3 dc* (154 dc)

Round 13: 7 dc, 2 dc in the next st, *10 dc, 2 dc in the next st*, 3 dc (168 dc)

Round 14: ch 1, *11 sc, 2 sc in the next st* (182 sc)





Round 15: [2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the first st, ch 5, skip 6 st, *[2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc] in the next st, ch 5, skip 6 st* (104 dc, 26 ch-2 sp, 26 ch-5 sp)

Round 16: *1 dc in each of the first 2 dc, 5 dc in ch-2 sp, 1 dc in each of the next 2 dc, 1 sc in ch-5 sp* (234 dc, 26 sc)

Round 17: sl st to the 3rd dc of 9, ch 1, *{1 sc, ch 3, skip 1 st} x 2, {1 sc, ch 3, skip 2 st} x 2* (104 sc, 104 ch-3 sp)

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Round 18: sl st into ch-sp, ch 1, 1 sc in ch-sp, ch 3, *1 sc in the next ch-sp, ch 3* (104 sc, 104 ch-3 sp)

Round 19: sl st into ch-sp, ch 1, *[1 sc, picot, 1 sc] in ch-sp, ch 5, skip 1 ch-sp, 1 sc in the next ch-sp, ch 5, skip 1 ch-sp* (78 sc, 26 picot, 52 ch-5 sp)

Fasten off. Weave in the ends. Block your finished doily for best results.
